Independence Day Celebration

Budweiser Coed Volleyball Tournament

Tournament Rules

1. Coed Six-Person ~ Minimum of 2 women on court during play.
2. Roster can have no more than 8 players.
3. All participants must be registered and sign the liability waiver before play can begin.
4. Play can begin if each team has a minimum of 5 players (2 women).
5. If a team fails to have 5 players on the court or do not have 2 women on the court at any given time, that team will forfeit the match.
6. Pool Play - A, B & C Pools
 - a. One Game, Rally scoring to 21.
 - b. Seeding for Tournaments based on Pool Wins and Points Allowed.
 - c. Top 3 or 4 from each Pool will be in Championship Bracket (Based on Entries).
7. Tournament Matches:
 - a. Championship Bracket (Dbl Elimination): Best of 3 Rally scoring to 21, 3rd game (if necessary) first to 15. If a third set is necessary, it is played to 15 points (20 point hard cap) with a minimum lead of two points.
 - b. Consolation Bracket (Single Elimination): Best of 3 Rally scoring to 21, 3rd game (if necessary) first to 15.
 - c. Paying for 1st – 3rd in Championship & Top Two in Consolation.
8. Net is set at men's regulation height.
9. Ball must be touched at least once by a woman before returned over the net (except on serve, doesn't need to be alternate).
10. Ball touching the boundary line is in.
11. It is permissible to be out of bounds to play a ball.
12. A ball, other than the serve, may be recovered from the net provided the player avoids contact with the net and does not catch or hold the ball.
13. A player shall not make successive contacts of the ball unless they have blocked a spike at the net, in which that initial contact does not count as a contact meaning the team has three more contacts to get the ball over the net.
14. All substitutions will be made in the center back position and all substitutes must make one complete rotation. Players late in arriving for a team of less than 6 can only rotate in when his/her team has the serve.
15. Teams are responsible for keeping track of the score throughout the game and the score should be announced prior to each serve.
